



# Cost of Attendance Worksheet

The total cost of attendance is unique for each student at each school. While some expenses are fixed (like tuition and fees) **others are influenced and controlled by the student**. All financial aid funds are first applied to the students "direct costs" for attending Trine University. Families must also plan for paying "indirect costs" unique to you (e.g. off-campus housing, books, transportation, misc. expenses, etc.). This worksheet was designed to assist you in determining your total out of pocket costs.
