OTTO GRUENBERG'S PHILOSOPHY: "You should use your mind to the best of your ability. If you put forth your best, I'll meet you halfway."

The Otto C. Gruenberg Scholarship seeks students who embody the values of hard work, ethics, civic responsibility, initiative, and dedication to excellence. Otto Gruenberg, a Tri-State College (now Trine University) graduate, was a mechanical engineer and railroad executive who served in both World Wars. His life was marked by service, integrity, and a commitment to education, railroading, and investing. The Gruenberg Foundation honors his legacy by awarding scholarships to U.S. students entering Trine University who demonstrate the high moral character and values Gruenberg cherished.

Why Apply: The Gruenberg Foundation Scholarship offers financial support to high school seniors entering Trine University, with awards starting at \$3,500, and an average award of \$6,500 last year. This scholarship honors students who embody Otto Gruenberg's values of ethics, leadership, dedication, and community service. Recipients can reapply for up to three additional years, provided they meet the academic and conduct requirements.

Criteria: Eligible applicants must be U.S. citizens, have a minimum GPA of 3.0, and rank in the top third of their high school class. Selection is based on factors such as academic performance, leadership, initiative, ethical standards, and financial need. Students should also demonstrate a commitment to their family and community and pledge to remain drug-free.

Conditions: The recipient must sign the Code of Conduct in the scholarship application and, as a demonstration of compliance to the actions and values reflected in the code, sign such a statement annually.

If a recipient chooses not to continue in the college program in a particular year, the award will be canceled and the unspent portion, if any, will be returned.

The Gruenberg Foundation Scholarships are not intended to displace other scholarship aid. Should you receive enough other financial aid, Trine will be requested to return to the foundation the portion of your Gruenberg scholarship which would displace other aid. The Gruenberg Foundation Scholarships may displace loans.

Scholarship awards are made at the discretion of the foundation's Scholarship Committee based on the Scholarship Advisory Committee recommendations.

Renewability: The scholarship can be renewed for up to three additional undergraduate years as long as recipients maintain full-time status, achieve a minimum 3.0 GPA, and uphold the scholarship's values. Renewal is not guaranteed and is subject to approval each year by the Scholarship Committee.

Non-renewal: If a recipient is denied renewal, they are no longer eligible to reapply.

Code of Conduct: Recipients must sign a Code of Conduct, reaffirming their commitment to the scholarship's values annually.

Scholarship Termination: If a recipient discontinues their college program, the scholarship will be canceled, and any unused funds must be returned to the foundation.

Direct Payment: Scholarship funds are paid directly to Trine University's Office of Student Accounts. Payments can be applied to tuition, fees, room, and board.

Disbursement: The first semester payment is made in August, and the second in December, once the recipient has signed the grant agreement and Trine University verifies their enrollment and financial aid package.

Financial Aid Impact: The scholarship will not displace other grant aid unless required by law, but may replace loans to reduce the student's financial burden.

Tax Guidelines: Awards are subject to state and federal income tax regulations.
