Starting a Student Organization

At Trine University, we have a vibrant student organization community with over 75 unique organizations. Our organizations range from service, special interest, religion, academic, and greek. If you don't find an organization that you like, you can start your own!

1. Membership Roster

Students wishing to start a new student organization on campus must have at least 6 members. Four of those members must be in executive roles.

2. Binding Documents

New student organizations must create and submit a constitution or mission statement.

3. Advisor Letter

All student organizations must have a faculty/staff member to serve the organization as an advisor. Advisors must submit a brief letter stating their commitment to serving as the advisor for the academic year on Trine letterhead.

4. Submit Request to Student Government

Lastly, you can submit your official documents to studentgovernment@trine.edu and request a meeting time to present.

5. Present to Student Senate

After the organization request has been processed, the Student Senate will invite the organization to present to the Student Senate for Student Government recognition. Student Senate meetings occur every Monday at 6:30 PM.
